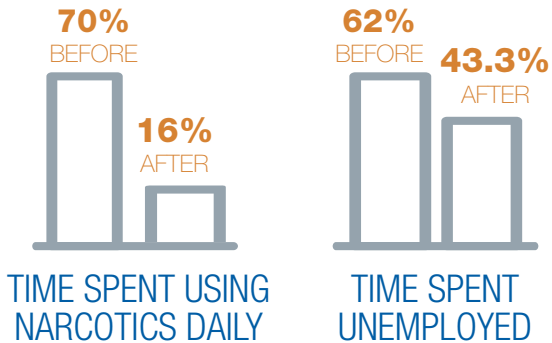


# THE IMPACT OF OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAMS

## REDUCED COSTS

Every \$1 invested in addiction treatment yields a return of between \$4 and \$7 in reduced drug-related crime, criminal justice costs and theft alone.

When savings related to health care are included, total savings can exceed costs by a ratio of 12:1.

## GOALS OF MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT

- Prevention or reduction of withdrawal symptoms
- Prevention or reduction in drug cravings
- Prevention of relapse to use of opiates
- Restoration toward normalcy of any physiological function disrupted by drug use
- Blockade of euphoric effects if opiates are used

## HOW WE CAN WORK WITH YOUR AGENCY

**Coordination of Care:** In most cases, our clinicians will have more contact with your patient than any other agency; as much as six days per week. Patients are encouraged to allow us to coordinate treatment and share information with their providers. Because of this frequent contact, our clinicians will be able to assess and determine patient needs, and to provide early intervention with appropriate referrals.
